Bee and wasp stings can bring on anaphylactic shock, which is pretty frightening to dogs and their humans. The treatment is usually a Benadryl type injection. In cases of getting stung-play it safe!



Healthy Homemade Dog Treats INGREDIENTS:

- -1 1/4* c. organic coconut oil for pets, melted
- ½ cup, slightly rounded, Brewers Yeast
- 2 small paw print shaped silicone pans
- 1. Combine melted coconut oil and brewers yeast together in a blender. Blend for roughly 10 seconds until smooth.
- 2. Transfer blended mixture into a plastic condiment bottle (trim tip to ¼" opening) and use to fill the silicone pans.
- 3. Chill in the refrigerator or freezer until set and solid.
- 4. Remove from the pan and store in refrigerator or freezer for up to 6 months.
